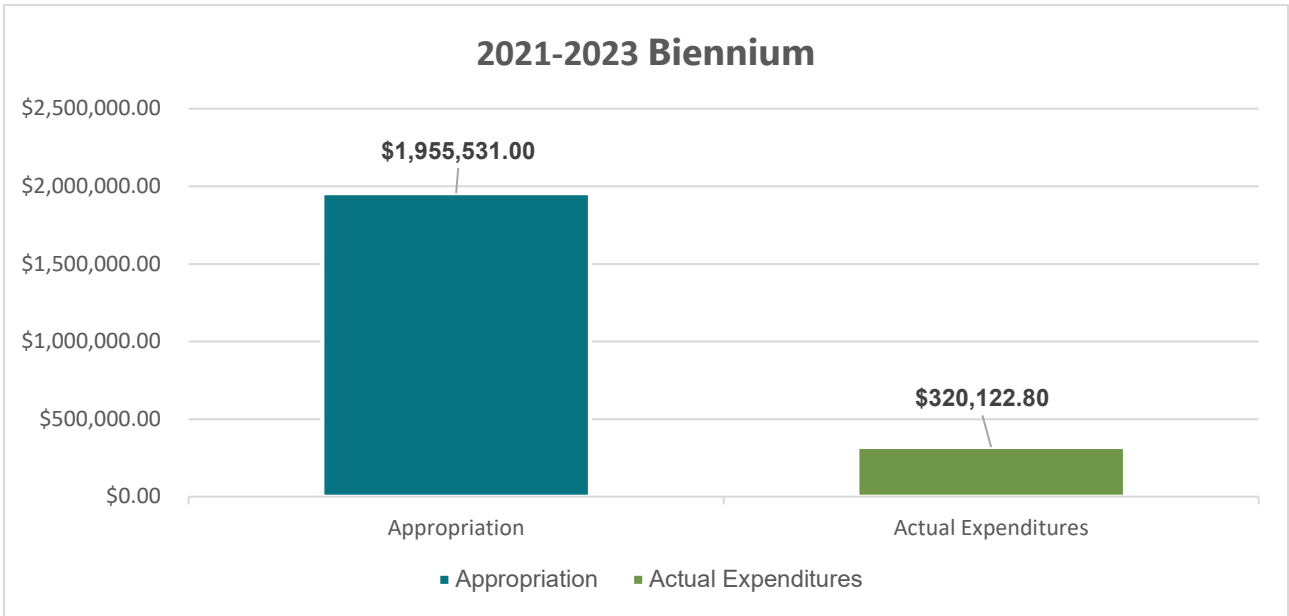
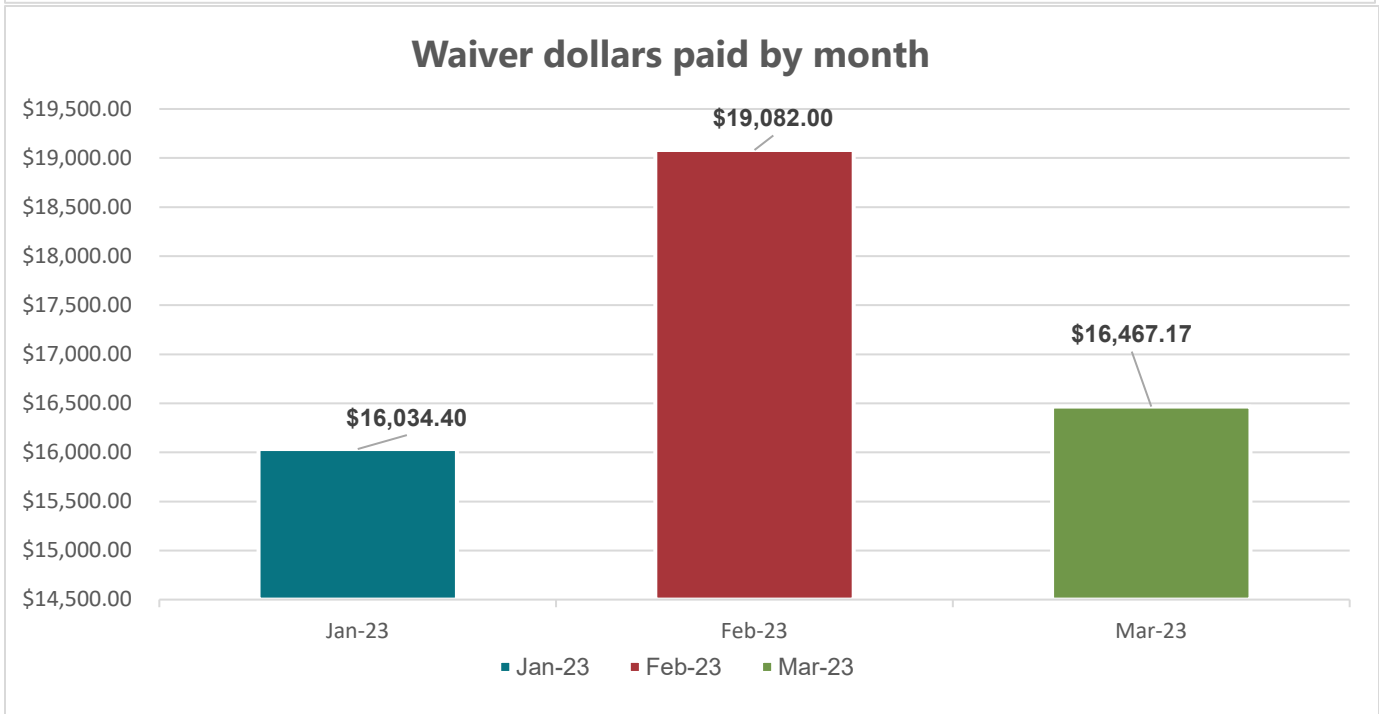
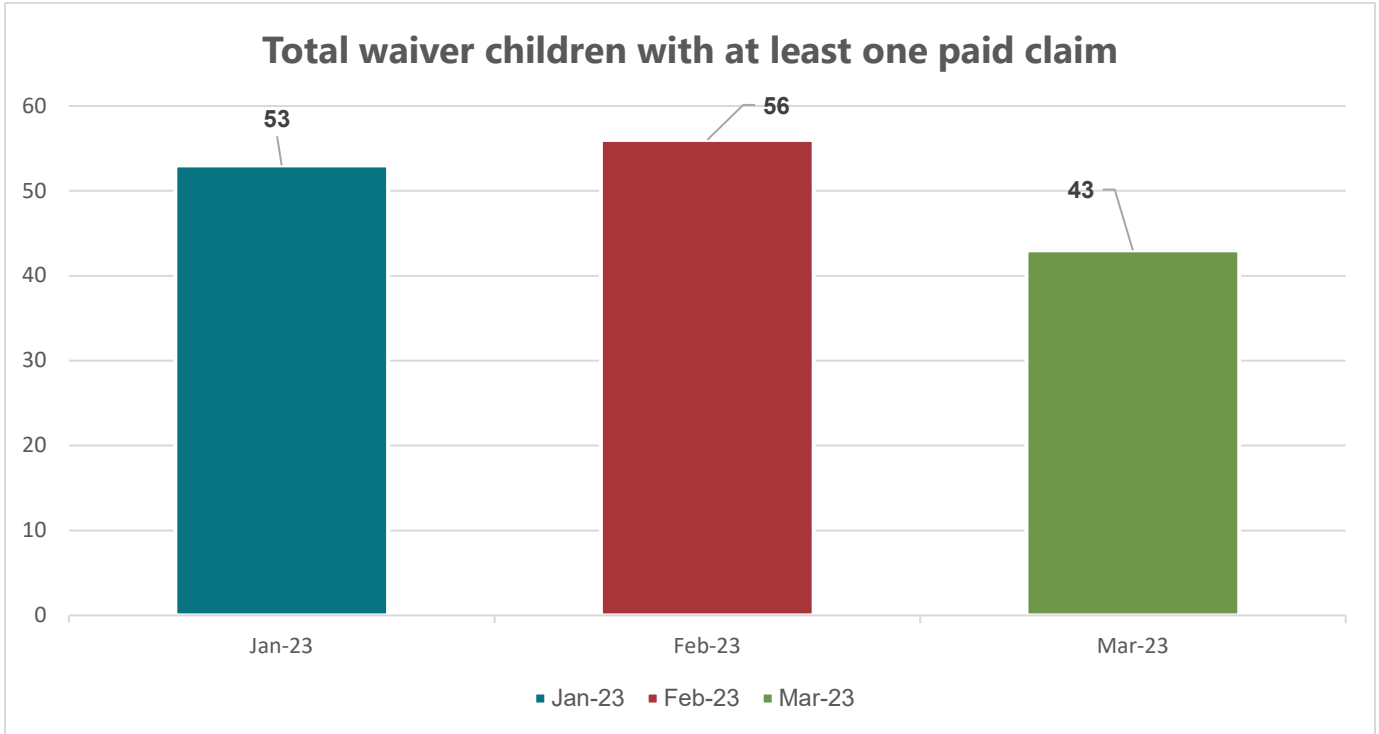
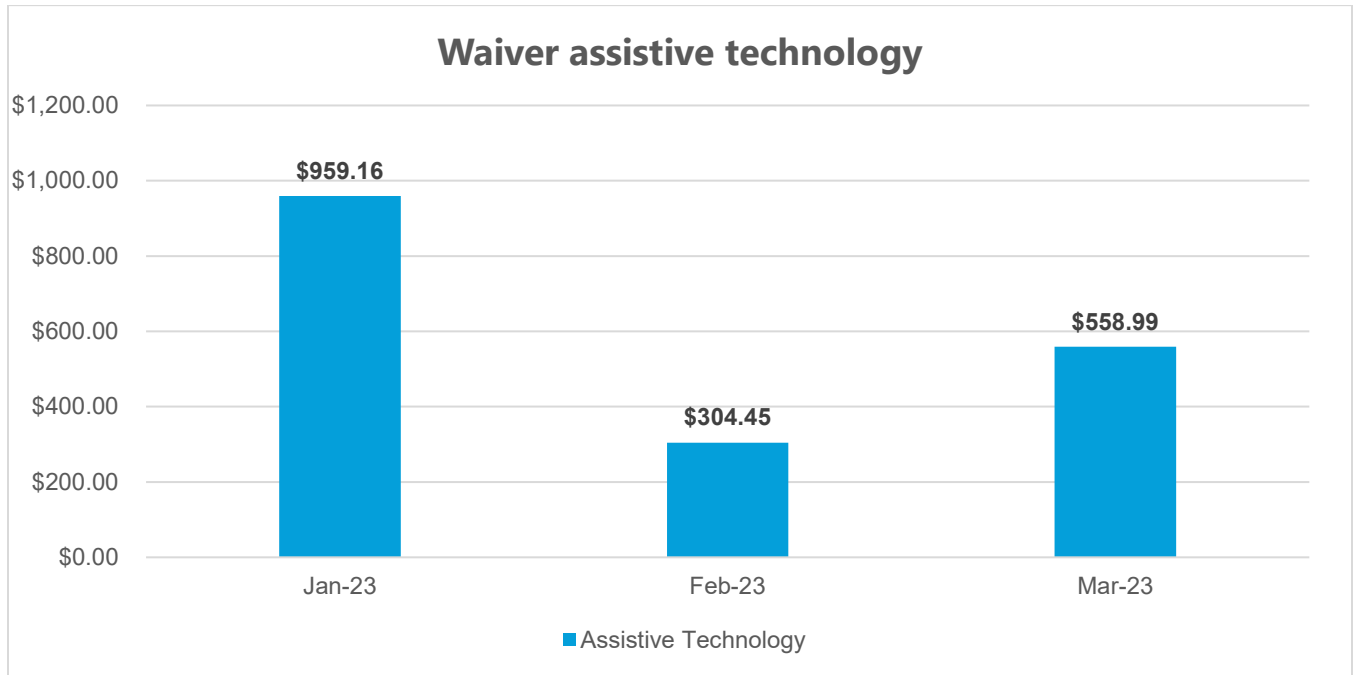


Medicaid Autism Waiver

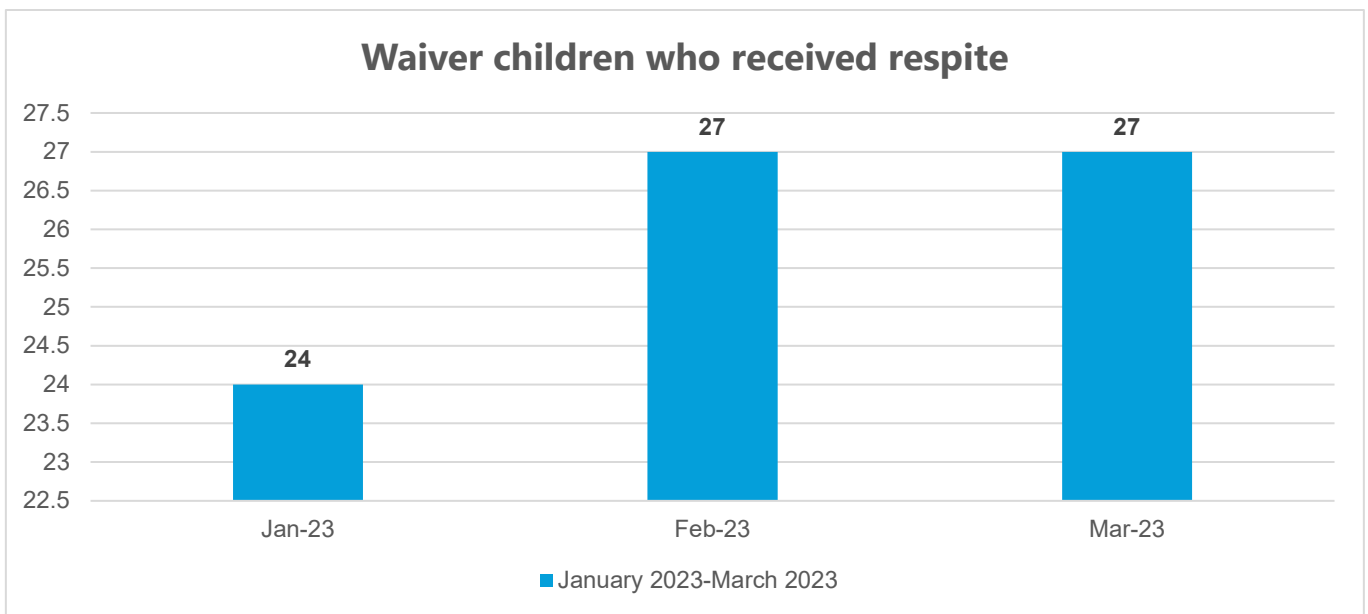

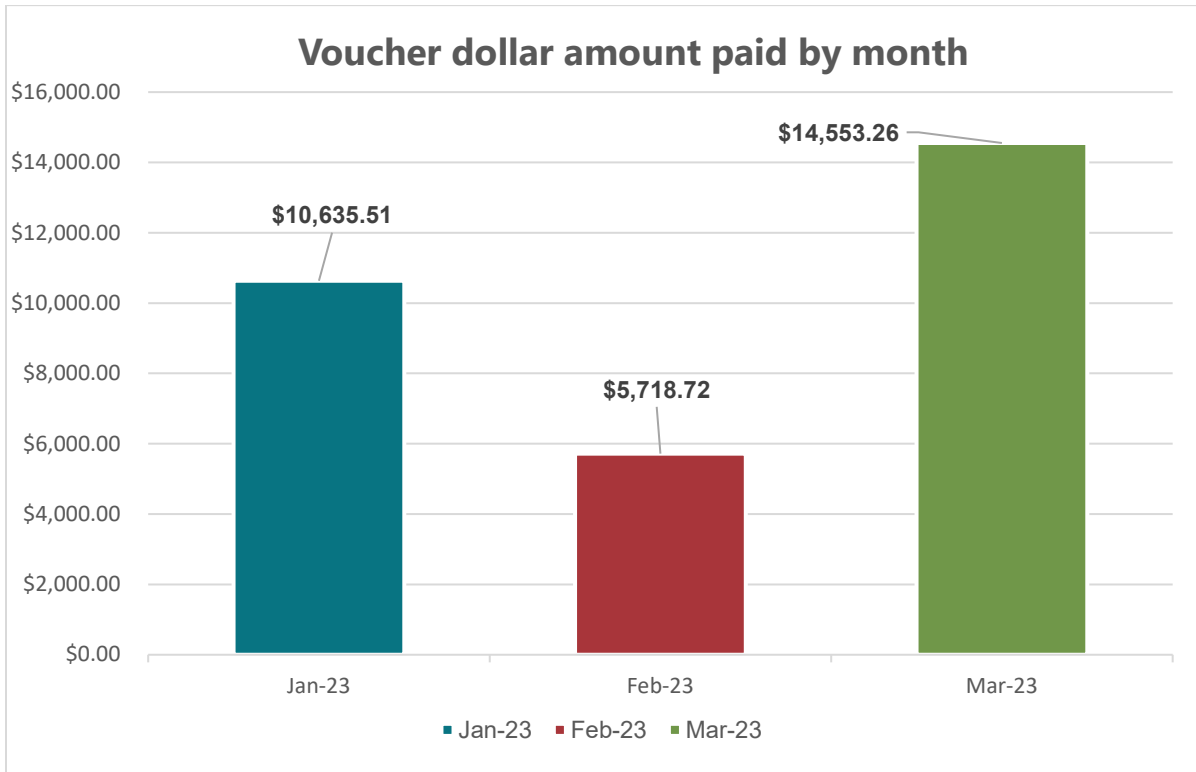
Total enrollment so far for the 2022-2023 program year is 37 children: 17 urban, 15 semi-rural, and 5 rural.

- January 2023-March 2023 enrollment: 8 children added to voucher. 4 urban, 4 semi-rural, and 0 rural.

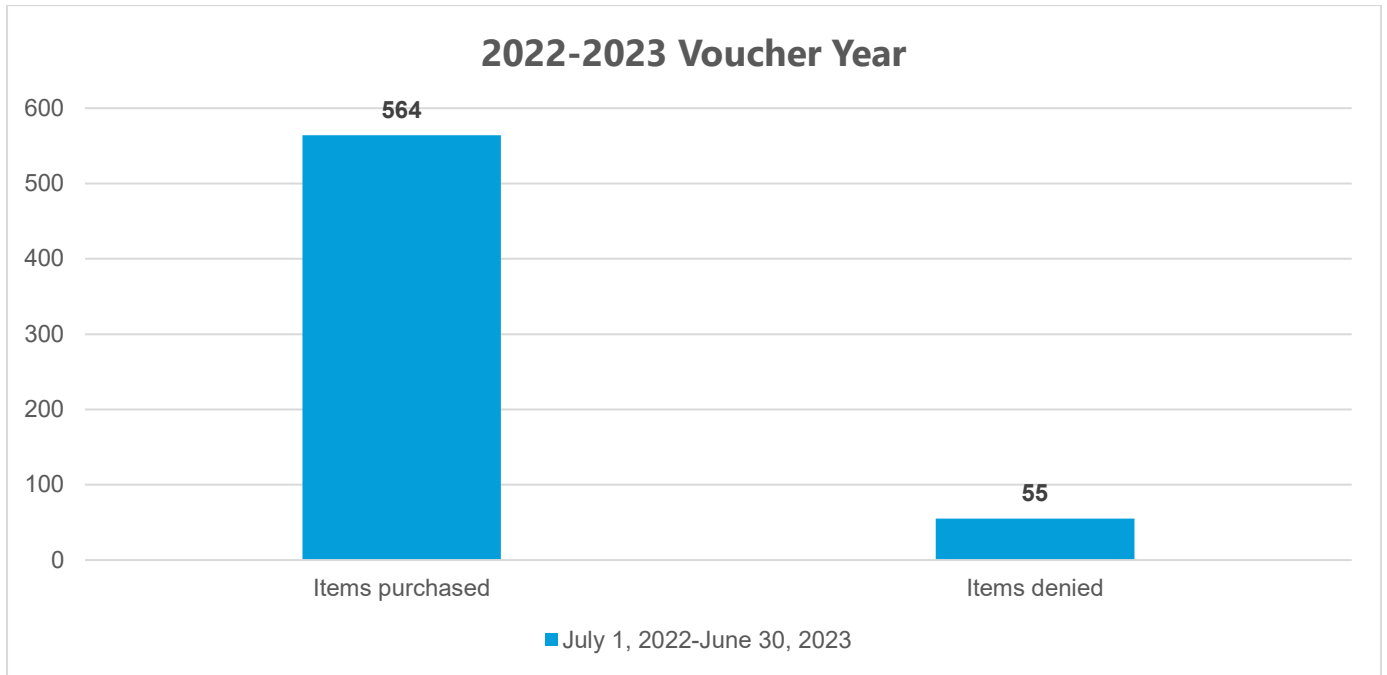




- January 2023 expenditures: 19 children; 9 urban, 6 semi-rural, and 4 rural

Voucher Items Purchased/Denied and Respite by year:



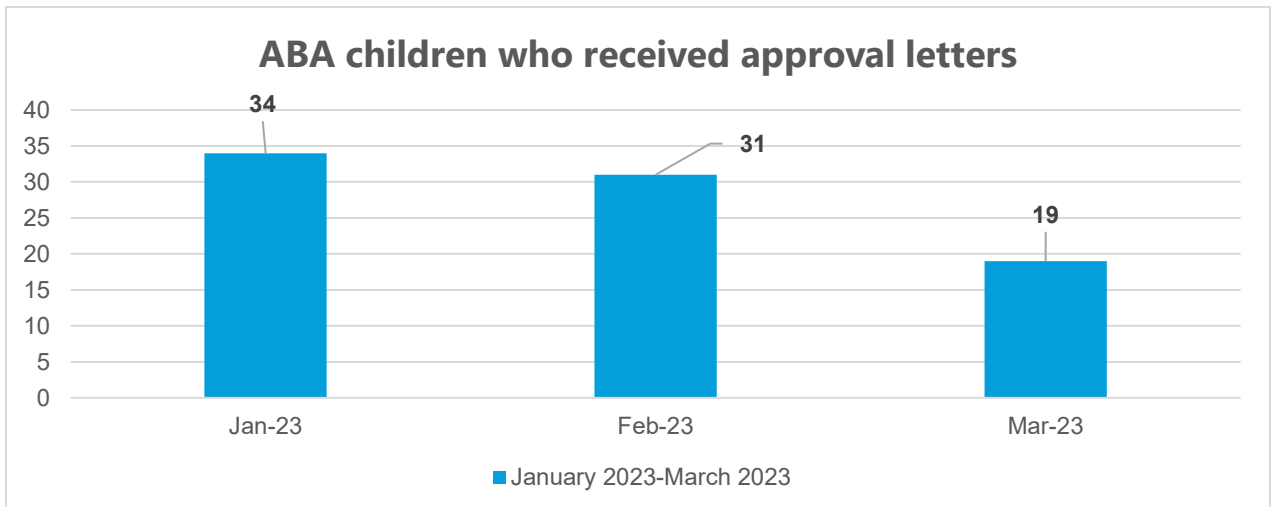
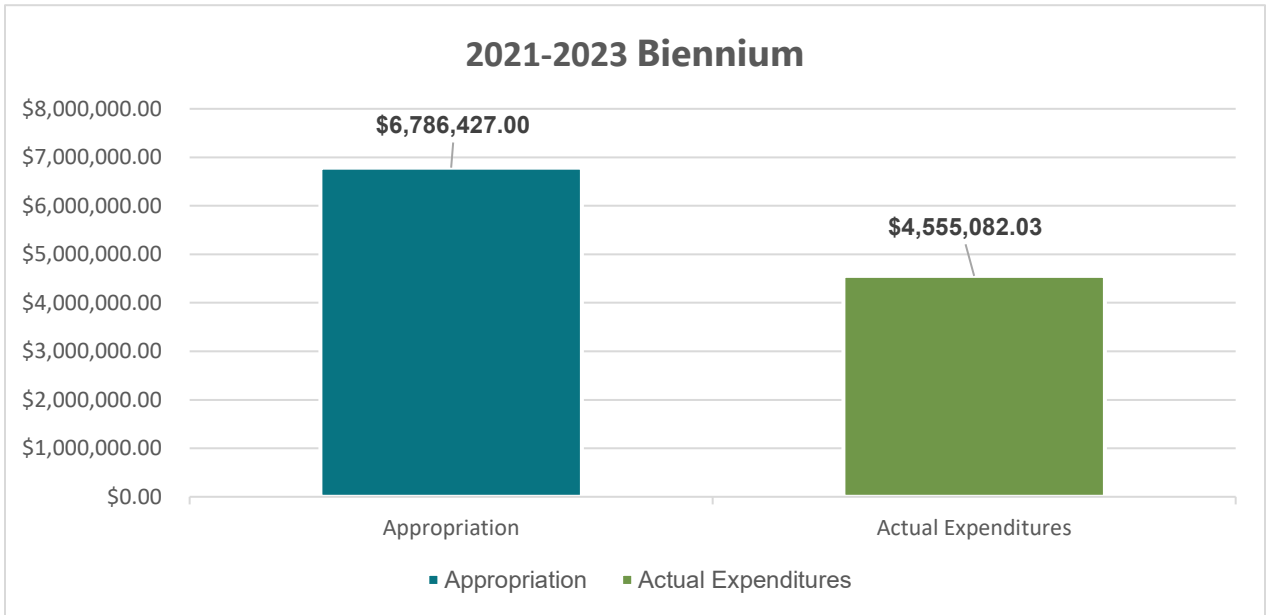
Summary:
