Dear Tribal Consultation Members:

This letter is regarding the Tribal Consultation between the North Dakota Department of Human Services and the North Dakota Indian Tribes. The consultation process was established to ensure Tribal governments are included in the decision-making processes when proposed changes in the Medicaid or Children's Health Insurance Program(s) will directly impact the North Dakota Tribes and/or their Tribal members.

North Dakota (ND) Medicaid Expansion is authorized under section 1915(b) of the Social Security Act (SSA). The 1915(b) Waiver for Managed Care Enrollment of the Medicaid Expansion permits the State to furnish services to those individual eligible for North Dakota Medicaid Expansion through a Managed Care Organization (MCO). This authority allows mandatory enrollment for individuals, including Native Americans, eligible for Medicaid Expansion into the plan offered by the contracted private carrier (managed care organization).

The Department is submitting a renewal request to the Centers of Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for the current Alternative Benefit Plan (ABP) which was approved as part of the January 1, 2014 implementation of the Medicaid Expansion coverage. The current authority granted by the ABP ends December 31, 2021 and in order to continue to provide coverage to those enrolled with Medicaid Expansion; a renewal request must be approved by CMS.


Medicaid Expansion program categories of benefits will remain the same. Most of the services that had limits under the current ABP those will be removed on January 1, 2022. There will be some additional limits to durable medical equipment and some additional services that will require prior authorization before the service can be performed. Medicaid State Plan Early Period Screening Diagnostic and Treatment program benefits, which are for children ages 19-20, will also be removed as those individuals are being transitioned t the Medicaid Fee for Service benefit and those benefits will be received under that program.
