


Laboratory Web Portal: Ordering Mandatory Reportable Isolates

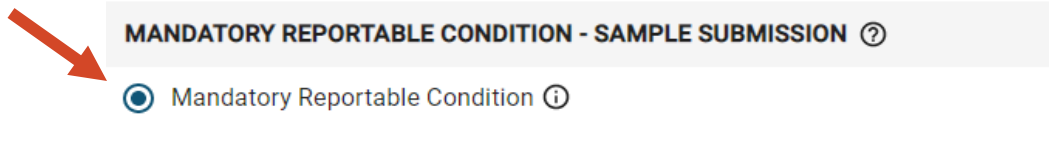
The following bacteria are a few of the most common Mandatory Reportable Conditions and should be ordered as such in the Lab Web Portal:

- ❖ Shiga toxin-producing *Escherchia coli*
- ❖ *Salmonella*
- ❖ *Shigella*
- ❖ *Vibrio*
- ❖ Carbapenem-resistant organisms
 - *Enterobacteriaceae*
 - *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*

- A Mandatory Reportable requiring an isolate submission is denoted with the () symbol on the Mandatory Reportable Conditions chart.

- If the isolate has not been fully identified order Aerobic Culture ID.

How to order Mandatory Reportable isolates/CIDTS:

Select the Mandatory Reportable Condition under the Mandatory Reportable Condition- Sample Submission header.

Once selected, the portal will prompt you to free text in the isolate that you are sending. The question 'Is this isolate for Carbapenemase testing?' will also be prompted.

If the isolate you are sending is for Carbapenemase testing, the portal will prompt you with another question/statement, 'Submit drug susceptibility with isolate'.

*A copy of the drug susceptibility report is required for each Carbapenemase isolate submitted.
