WHO?

Medicaid members and others at risk of needing Medicaid to help pay for health care and long-term care

WHAT?

If your nursing facility stay is going to be 6 months or less, you need to ask your health care provider to fill out and submit *State Form #132, Physician Statement for Medicaid Temporary Stay Review for Individuals Entering a Long-Term Care Facility*. **Find this form** at www.nd.gov/eforms/Doc/sfn00132.pdf.

WHY?

- It impacts how North Dakota calculates Medicaid benefits.
- This allows Medicaid members to have more funds to keep their home while they are temporarily living in a long-term care facility.
- This helps people pay rent, utilities and other housing costs while away, so they can return home.
