



# Child Care Assistance Program Application Checklist

The Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) helps pay a portion of the cost of childcare for working families, or families in training or education programs.

Families with low income who meet certain eligibility criteria qualify for the program.

## DOCUMENTS TO HAVE WHEN YOU APPLY:

- Completed CCAP application
- Driver's license or picture ID
- Birth certificates for the children
- Verification of court ordered child support or court ordered spousal support deduction (if applicable)
- Proof of income (last month and current month)
- Social Security Number (SSN) for the caretaker and for each child  
**Note:** The SSN helps with accurate identification. If you do not wish to give SSNs it will not affect your participation in this program.
