Krissie Guerard: Health Equity Office

- Cultural Competency Training was developed, 1 hour, posted on the HE website and link included in the chat.

- The Youth Advisory Board is working on a Healthy Habit Campaign. A contractor will be hired within the next month and hoping the campaign will start March of next year.

- Just wrapped up a survey in which 25% of people living with HIV in ND responded and overall people feel they are receiving the care they need, happy with healthcare and other services. There are some gaps with mental help support. Also, did 15 target key informant interviews
- Currently in process of developing a provider survey to assess the knowledge and gaps and assessing stigma as it relates to sexual health services and drug treatments.
- There is currently a general sexual health survey open and available. Alicia Belay has been attending Pride events across the state to get the survey in to the hands of those who are at risk for HIV, Hep, etc.
