## Common questions about the COVID-19 vaccine

### Who can get the COVID-19 vaccine?

All North Dakota residents age 16 years and older may now receive a COVID-19 vaccination.

#### What are common side effects after vaccination?

Common side effects from vaccination include pain, swelling or redness where the shot was given, a mild fever, chills, fatigue, headache, and muscle and joint aches. For vaccines that require two doses, side effects are more common after the second dose for both Pfizer and Moderna.

#### How much will the COVID-19 vaccine cost?

COVID-19 vaccines are distributed for free. Health care providers are able to charge a fee to administer the vaccine. Health insurance will cover these fees. Those who are uninsured and unable to pay the administration fee cannot be turned away.
