OTHER LICENSED PROVIDERS

ND Medicaid covers licensed practitioners referred to in policy as Other Licensed Practitioners (OLPs) pursuant to <u>42 CFR § 440.60</u>. Enrolled OLPs recognized by ND Medicaid and authorized under attachment 3.1-A Item 6.d and Attachment 3.1-B Item 6.d may bill ND Medicaid for covered services allowed within their scope of practice.

Practitioners currently recognized as OLPs by ND Medicaid are:

- Nurse Practitioners (NPs)
- Physicians Assistants (PAs)
- Certified Nurse Midwives (CNMs)
- Clinical Nurse Specialists (CNSs)
- Licensed Psychologists
- Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSWs)
- Licensed Professional Clinical Counselors (LPCCs)
- Licensed Professional Counselors (LPCs)
- Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFTs)
- Licensed Addiction Counselors (LACs)
- Licensed Psychologists

NPs, CNMs, CNSs, and PAs must receive an individual provider number even if they are a member of a group, clinic, or employed by an outpatient hospital or other organized health care delivery system.

Medicaid billable services consist of services otherwise covered as a physician service that are within the scope of practice of the NP, CNM, CNS, or PA license.

Nurse practitioners and physician assistants may serve as primary care providers (PCP) within the Primary Care Case Management (PCCM) program.
