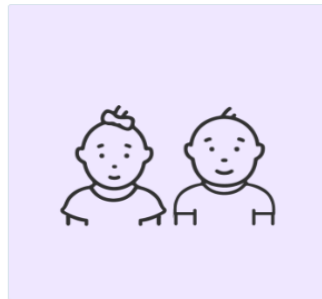

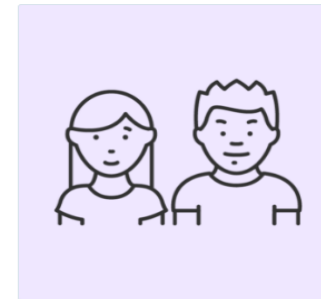
9-24 Months Old



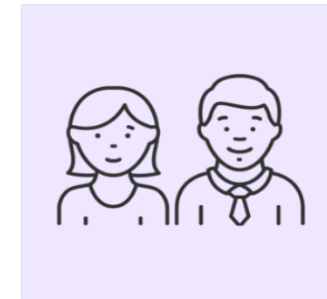
3-6 Years Old

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PMHCA NEXT QUARTER PLANS

The following is a list of activities scheduled for completion prior to Sept. 29, 2023

- ④ Assist the Behavioral Health Division with the PMHCA continuation grant application as needed, due June 12th.
- ④ Pilot implementation of screening tool w/ Dr. Connell at UND prior to disbursement.
 - ④ Time taken for screening completion without tool/with tool, scoring and recommendation
- ④ Continue the bi-monthly ECHO session with pediatric primary care providers.
- ④ Confirm marketing contract and campaign for May –Sept.
- ④ Conduct clinic site visits throughout ND (June)
- ④ Join Northland Clinics for their annual sports screening
- ④ Complete the purchase and disbursement of the Reaching Teens curriculum from the American Academy of Pediatrics
 - ④ This program is available to adults who work with youth.
 - ④ Provides free CME's for pediatricians from AAP, certificates of completion for other professionals to use with their perspective boards.
- ④ Coordinate and host three professional training days with the Reach Institute.
 - ④ Topics will include Primary Care Treatment of Anxiety (July), Disruptive Behavior (August) and Depression (September)
